The next clinic is on Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> May – the surgery will be closed from 13:30 to enable us to vaccinate all eligible patients within the locality. Further clinic/s are planed - Saturday 27<sup>th</sup> May and, based on uptake and demand, further clinics may be announced. ## Friends and Family feedback and action plans January to April 2023

We are grateful for all the positivity and, most of all, the understanding that we are endeavouring to provide the best service we can, within the resources we are given, and are often stretched to the limit.

It is noted that appointment and telephone access are still a source of frustration and we have answered three questions below:

- Q Why have you only got one telephone line?
- A We have one telephone number with ten lines attached. In the practice's business plan, when seven lines are taken, calls are diverted to other members of the team. There is still a call queue which is an indicator of how many calls come in all day, every day. As mentioned in the previous newsletter, in acknowledgement of feedback received in the Friends and Family comments, the practice is considering a new telephone system with 'queue busting' functionality. The practice is obliged to purchase a system from an NHS preferred supplier and we will keep you informed of progress.
- Q Why aren't there more appointments available for online booking?
- A We balance the needs of our patient population by providing urgent and routine appointments bookable face to face in reception, by telephone and online. This question will be highlighted in our improvement plan for review.
- Q Why can't I have a face-to-face Drs appointment?
- A You can all you need to do is specify your preference when you book the appointment

Thank you for all your contributions to Friends & Family. Please note that we pass on all person-specific comments to the person mentioned. It is a real morale booster.

### **Changes to repeat medications**

Please order your medications in sufficient time to avoid running out during the upcoming May Bank Holidays:

From 1st April 2023, patients that require urgent repeat medication, for example because of them running out of a repeat medication, or because they have left home without it, will be able to obtain an urgent supply via pharmacies commissioned under the Pharmacist Consultation Service. Patients requiring an urgent supply will need to contact NHS111 to be referred to a participating pharmacy. Patients will no longer be able to be referred via GP Practices or GP Out of Hours providers.
